The photo adventure can be extended to sky100 after 6:00 pm. Located on the 100th floor of International Commerce Centre – the tallest building in Hong Kong – the attraction at the height of 393m is the best place to capture the “Million-dollar Night View” of the Victoria Harbour and the Kowloon Peninsula.

The Ngong Ping Cable Car stretches 5.7 km from Tung Chung to Ngong Ping. Guests can visit the Chinese architecturally designed Ngong Ping Village, where they can enjoy a wide range of dining, shopping and entertainment options and culturally themed attractions, including VR 360, Motion 360 and Walking with Buddha. The Ngong Ping Cable Car is a rare example of a bi-cable gondola circulating lift system, and is the longest aerial cable car system of its kind in Asia. It offers a visually spectacular 25-minute journey with panoramic views of the flora and fauna of North Lantau Country Park, Tung Chung Bay and the Hong Kong International Airport.
