

sky100 Hong Kong Observation Deck 2020 New Year's Eve Countdown

(20 December 2019, Hong Kong) As announced by The Hong Kong Tourism Board on 18 December 2019, the 2020 New Year's Eve Fireworks Display on 31 December 2019 will be cancelled. It will be replaced by an enriched version of "Symphony of Lights", an iconic multimedia show, plus the pyrotechnics released from rooftops of buildings along the Victoria Harbour, the giant countdown clock display on the glass curtain wall of the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre and an online lucky draw.

Situated at 393m above sea level, sky100 Hong Kong Observation Deck (sky100) offers 360-degree panoramic views of the city's nightscape. It has been one of the best vantage points for watching the "Symphony of Lights", including the above countdown activities. Hence, despite the cancellation of the "2020 New Year's Countdown Fireworks, **sky100 will continue to extend its opening hours on the New Year's Eve till 01:00 on 1 Jan 2020** (with last admission at 23:30), to countdown with local and overseas visitors and ring in 2020!
